



Camp Counselor – Horse Corral

Essential duties:

1. Provide daily supervision of children in an overnight camp environment.
2. Plan, lead, and engage with campers in recreational activities, skits, games, songs, activities, and other planned events as part of daily camp living.
3. Lead by example, acting as a positive role model of the OLVC values of Respect, Trust, Integrity, Passion, Teamwork, and Accountability and Camp Turner's of Hospitality, Stewardship, Social Justice, Personal Growth, and Recreation.
4. Work in the horse corral, teaching children how to ride/care for horses.
5. Help with dishwashing, janitorial tasks, grounds work, maintenance, camp photography, activity set up/tear down, and occasional administrative duties.
6. Proper execution, reporting, and communication of CT and OLVC emergency procedures, incident and accident reporting, and safety guidelines.
7. Attend, participate and successfully complete all summer camp training sessions and CT staff meetings as scheduled.
8. Assist with the care, maintenance, upkeep and cleaning of all CT facilities and equipment, including the horse corral.
9. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

1. 17 years of age required; 18 years of age preferred.
2. Experience with teaching horsemanship and caring for horses, and safety practices preferred.
3. High school diploma or equivalent preferred.
4. Previous experience working with children ages 6-17 preferred.
5. Must be willing to live on site for summer season with room and board provided.
